# What is Cloud Computing?

- Cloud Computing refers to both the applications delivered as services over the Internet and the hardware and systems software in the datacenters that provide those services. Datacenter hardware and software is what we will call a Cloud.
- Cloud computing has the following characteristics:
  - 1. The **illusion of infinite** resources...
  - 2. The elimination of an up-front commitment by Cloud users...
  - 3. The ability to pay for use ... as you need..."
